

## Cycle 3: High School (G9-10 Boys)

Students in G9 and G10 boys will attend on campus classes every other day alternating in groups of Group A and Group B from 9am-2:45pm Sunday- Thursday. They will have 6 class periods per day.

Our plan is to have each class split into two groups. Group A will attend and Group B will watch the livestream at home for distance learning, the next day Group B will attend on campus and Group A will watch the livestream at home for distance learning. This secures that students are attending in the first week 2/3 split and in the second week a 3/2 split. This secures that social distancing takes place in the classrooms and students get equal face-to-face time with the teachers throughout the week.

Subject information- G9 and G10 Moral education will be integrated into English classes; Grade 9 students will make their elective choice decisions during orientation and can choose to take Health and Food Science, English Literature, Computer Science, or Genetics. G9 students are required to take their Visual and Performing Arts course. Students will be able to choose from VPA: Art Design, VPA: Drama, or VPA: Concert Band. G9 students will take virtual classes each week for PE, UAE Social Studies, and Visual and Performing Arts.

Grade 10 students will make their elective choice decisions during orientation and can choose to take Design & Technology, Accounting, Genetics, or English Literature. G10 students will take virtual classes each week for PE and a portion of their elective classes.

The school will provide livestream distance learning for SOD students and any students who do not attend school for health reasons.
